65% of lamb growth occurs in the last 6 weeks before lambing

Reduce lamb mortality - 49% of lamb losses occur in the first 48 hours, hypothermia and starvation are the major causes

Castration or tailing should not occur until ewe & lamb bond is established or after 7 days of age



- Watch for signs of twin lamb disease and calcium deficiency
- Clostridial disease vaccination booster
- Keep vitamins and minerals topped up
- Check for signs of prolapse



ENDURABOL SHEEP:
